Main Idea

God wants to help you deal with your fears

Discussion Questions

- 1. How would you describe Gideon?
- 2. One moment Gideon is completely sure (v. 22, 24) of God and the next time he's unsure (v. 13, 15, 17). How are you like Gideon in this regard?
- 3. In the past couple of years, what has been two "sure" signs of God's presence with you? What are two present?
- 4. Think about a time when you felt pestered by life's fears. What caused your fears and how did you respond to them?
- 5. What comes to mind when you think of peace?

Yahweh Shalom (v. 24): is the Hebrew title rather than a name for God. Shalom is a greeting of hello & good-bye but means more than just that. Typically in English we look at the word "Shalom" as peace; the absence of outward conflict or a state of inner calmness. However, Shalom is expressing to someone that they are one with God; fulfilled, satisfied, healthy, in harmony with themselves, others & most importantly with God. **God is the source of peace.**

God wants to remind you that the peace you long for only comes from Him who can help you overcome your fears!

Ponder: If you have been feeling restless, anxious, stressed, harassed or maybe even oppressed; take a look inside. Ask yourself this week; what's stealing my peace?
